Current Programs

SPOKEN FOR

This program works with people who are trafficking survivors and provides them with the following:

- Transitional Housing
- Case management
- Transportation
- Stability Shelter
- Other Material Resources



THE HARBOUR

This program is a drop-in center for youth experiencing homelessness. It is designed to prevent predatory trafficking of homeless teens and includes the following:

- A safe, non-judgmental space for restoration
- Food & clothing
- Showers & toiletries



OUTREACH

A program to engage perceived trafficking survivors/victims & youth experiencing homelessness:

- Street outreach
- Seasonal outreach
- Location specific outreach



AWARENESS

This community awareness program provides presentations on youth homelessness & human trafficking-related topics around the state of New Mexico.

Future Programs

THE LIGHTHOUSE

This will be a system of group homes for youth trafficking survivors, which will be the first of its kind in the state. New Mexico currently doesn't have any specialized beds or programs for this population. This program will include the following:

- A family teaching model of residential living
- Highly individualized, multidisciplinary treatment plans designed by mental health specialists
- 4-6 youths per housing unit, staffed by a "house parent"
- Focus on community building
