

Greater Albuquerque Hotel & Lodging Association Scholarship Application

Purpose:

In accordance with the mission of our association, the Greater Albuquerque Hotel & Lodging Association (GAHLA) Board of Directors has developed a scholarship program for dedicated students pursuing a degree in a Hospitality Management Program.

It is the intent of GAHLA to identify, assist and encourage students to pursue a career in the hospitality industry within the State of New Mexico. Scholarships of \$500-1,000 will be awarded annually at the December Holiday Luncheon. Selected applicants and one guest will be invited to the luncheon. Decisions are made in late November.

Scholarship Eligibility:

- Candidate must be a resident of New Mexico or participate in a school internship program partnering with a New Mexico hospitality business
- Recipients of the scholarship must be enrolled either as a part-time or full-time student in the Hotel, Restaurant & Tourism Management Program or Culinary Arts Program at an accredited university or college in New Mexico
- Student must maintain a "C" or higher overall grade average with a "B" or higher average in major courses
- Student may reapply annually provided the above criteria are met
- Proof of current enrollment is required for scholarship selection

Application Deadline, Candidate Selection and Awards Luncheon:

Deadline: Application must be received by November 22, 2024.

Selection of scholarship winners will be made as follows:

- Candidate must submit completed application by stated deadline
- The Scholarship Committee will review all completed applications, and the members of this Committee will select the scholarship recipients
- Scholarship winners will be notified no later than November 24, 2024.
- The Awards Luncheon will take place in early December (specific date TBD) in Albuquerque at the Sheraton Uptown Hotel. We encourage those awarded to attend this Holiday luncheon. It is a great opportunity to meet leaders in the industry as well as network with potential future employers. GAHLA will host your meal and a meal for one guest. If you would like to bring additional guests, you may; cost for the luncheon is \$45 per additional guest.
